Accommodations of the University of Tokyo (2024 Spring move-ins)

Kitchens, laundries, lavatories, shower rooms etc. are shared at some of the UTokyo accommodations. Those approved to renew the permitted term of stay may stay up to the end of their current regular term of enrollment.

Students who have been admitted for their graduate courses at UTokyo during/after their initial 1-year stay will have to apply anew for their stay beyond through the online system. Reapplications may not always be admitted in this case depending on the number of applications received at the time, so please ready yourself to seek for alternative housing, as well.

III. International Halls of Residence

Toshima International Halls of Residence are accommodations mainly for degree-seeking students with no scholarships. Students are permitted to stay there during their term of enrollment. Mitaka International Hall of Residence, on the other hand, is mainly for new exchange students. The term of residence is the same as the period of your enrollment at UTokyo.

Although the living floors of the Mitaka International Hall of Residence are basically gender-segregated, we plan to change some of the floors to gender-neutral floors beginning in FY2024. Gender-neutral floors are residential floors that are open to anyone regardless of gender on various official certificates*.
