**All fees at the Mejirodai International Village will be charged based on your permitted term of residence. The "Entrance Fee," "Mattress Cover Fee," and Rent (Accommodation Fee + Maintenance Fee + Utilities Fee) for the move-in month will need to be paid within one week from the date of your move-in. Please note that you will be asked to pay the Rent (Accommodation Fee + Maintenance Fee + Utilities Fee) for the next month by the 25th day of your move-in month, as well.

- *As there is no kitchen and stove inside the Independent T type room, residents will need to use the kitchen on the 1st floor for cooking. In addition, residents of the Independent E, T and G type rooms will need to use the common laundry as the rooms do not come with a washing machine.

III. International Halls of Residence

Toshima International Halls of Residence are accommodations mainly for degree-seeking students with no scholarships. Students are permitted to stay there during their term of enrollment. Mitaka International Hall of Residence, on the other hand, is mainly for new exchange students. The term of residence is the same as the period of your enrollment at UTokyo.

Although the living floors of the Mitaka International Hall of Residence are basically gender-segregated, we changed some of the floors to gender-neutral floors beginning in FY2024. Gender-neutral floors are residential floors that are open to anyone regardless of gender on various official certificates*.

* various official certificates: Passport, birth certificate, etc.
