Accommodations of the University of Tokyo (2025 Autumn move-ins)

I. Mejirodai International Village

With various events now conducted and planned at the Mejirodai International Village, the communal life with diverse people is sure to cultivate your communication skills and widen your international horizons. Those approved to renew their permitted term of stay at the dorm may stay up until the end of their current regular term of enrollment at the university.

In addition, applications for the students' independent type rooms at the Linear Bldg, are now open to all students from May 26, 2024.

Please kindly note that students who have newly been admitted for their graduate course studies at UTokyo within/after their current initial stay at the dorm will all need to apply anew for their stays onwards as master/doctoral course students through the online system, which will always accompany a room change when admitted.

While there are separate male and female floors for the shared type rooms at the Mejirodai International Village, an all-gender residential area has partially been introduced as an all-inclusive space for anyone to live together regardless of their gender*.

*gender indicated on various official certificates such as passports, residence cards, individual number cards (the social security and tax number system known as "My Number" in Japan), driver licenses, etc.

XAll fees at the Mejirodai International Village will be charged based on your permitted term of residence. The "Entrance Fee," "Mattress Cover Fee," and Rent (Accommodation Fee + Maintenance Fee + Utilities Fee) for the move-in month will need to be paid within one week from the date of your move-in. Please note that you will be asked to pay the Rent (Accommodation Fee + Maintenance Fee + Utilities Fee) for the next month by the 25th day of your move-in month, as well.

- **As there is no kitchen and stove inside the Independent T type room, residents will need to use the kitchen on the 1st floor for cooking. In addition, residents of the Independent E, T and G type rooms will need to use the common laundry as the rooms do not come with a washing machine.

II. International Halls of Residence

Toshima International Halls of Residence are accommodations mainly for degreeseeking students with no scholarships. Students are permitted to stay there during their term of enrollment. Mitaka International Hall of Residence, on the other hand, is mainly for new exchange students. The term of residence is the same as the period of your enrollment at UTokyo.

While living floors at the Mitaka International Hall of Residence and Toshima International Hall of Residence Building A are mostly separated by gender, an allgender living environment has partially been introduced at both dorms as an allinclusive space for anyone to live together regardless of their gender*.

<All-Gender Floors>

All-Gender Floors are partially introduced at the Mejirodai International Village, Mitaka International Hall of Residence and Toshima International Hall of Residence Building A as an all-inclusive space for anyone to live together regardless of their gender*. For the details on the statement on the introduction of All-Gender Floors and the floor overview of each dorm, please refer to the following text and the information described above about each dormitory building. As rooms at the Komaba Lodge Main, Komaba Lodge Annex and Kashiwa Lodge are all equipped with the basic water-related facilites (toilet, shower, bathroom), floor allotments for these dorms will be conducted randomly as before regardless of gender.

**gender indicated on various official certificates such as passports, residence cards, individual number cards (the social security and tax number system known as "My Number" in Japan), driver licenses, etc.

Please ensure that you fully understand the distinctive features of the shared facilities at each dorm building and the purpose of introducing the All-Gender Floors before applying.

The University's policy regarding the introduction of all-gender floors in the UTokyo student dormitories is as follows.

Statement on the Introduction of All-Gender Floors in University Housing

The University of Tokyo articulated our commitment to respecting diversity in the University of Tokyo Charter and further adopted the University of Tokyo Statement on Diversity & Inclusion in June 2022 to announce the university's policy of respecting diversity and promoting inclusion. Additionally, in February 2024, the university published our Guidelines for Students on Diversity of Sexual Orientation and Gender Identity at the University of Tokyo.

University housing facilities are established with the expectation that university community members with diverse attributes, backgrounds, and values will deepen mutual understanding through daily life, promote cross-cultural and international exchange, and thereby build broad human relationships. Based on these principles, all-gender floors will be established in university housing as inclusive spaces where people can reside regardless of their sex or gender identity. While maintaining gender-segregated floors for residents who do not wish to choose all-gender floors, the university's management policy for housing is that all-gender floors will become the standard option once adequate measures to ensure individual privacy and safety have been put in place.

Toward that goal, the university will increasingly offer options other than gendersegregated floors in order to create an environment where diverse students can live with peace of mind while taking into consideration the architectural characteristics of each housing facility.
