- All -Gender Floors are partially introduced at the Mejirodai International Village, Mitaka International Hall of Residence and Toshima International Hall of Residence Building A as an all-inclusive space for anyone to live together regardless of their gender*. For the details on the statement on the introduction of All-Gender Floors and the floor overview of each dorm, please refer to the information attached herewith on the UTokyo accommodations. As rooms at the Komaba Lodge Main, Komaba Lodge Annex and Kashiwa Lodge are all equipped with the basic water-related facilities (toilet, shower, bathroom), floor allotments for these dorms will be conducted randomly as before regardless of gender.

- If you choose to live in an all-gender environment, please be sure to select the accommodation options either indicated as "All-Gender Floor" or "Independent" when applying through OSTA. Reasons for choices do not need to be indicated. If you are to have any special requests for room allotment, please individually contact the relative department in charge of the dorm you would like to select. Depending on the content of your request, we may ask to hold an interview to further assess your personal needs. Please kindly understand that due to the availability of rooms and other factors, we may not always be able to accommodate your request.
- The Mejirodai International Village and the other UTokyo accommodations cannot be applied for at the same time. Please check the OSTA Application Flow chart for details.
- Doctoral course students at UTokyo, including newly enrolled students for their doctoral studies from 2026 spring, are also eligible to apply for the Oiwake International Village. For the details, please refer to the UTokyo Housing Office website. However, applicants will need to note that they are not able to double file their applications for the Oiwake International Village and the International Lodges/International Halls of Residence at the same time.

OApplication Eligibility

- Applicants who have lived in either one of the UTokyo Accommodations for more than six months* in the past three years are not eligible to apply. If you have been or are a resident, please indicate so in the "Notes" column on the online form along with the name of the dorm and the length of your stay. Please note that any false entries may lead to the invalidation of the given room permit.
- * Even if the use of the room had only been for one day during the corresponding month, it is to be counted as a month's stay in terms of occupancy.

OInvalidation of the Dorm Admission Permit

- Permits may be invalidated even after room assignment if in the case it is found that the applicant does not meet the eligibility criteria or there is a significant discrepancy in the filed application or if there are to be any missing or incomplete documents that need to have been submitted by the due deadline.
